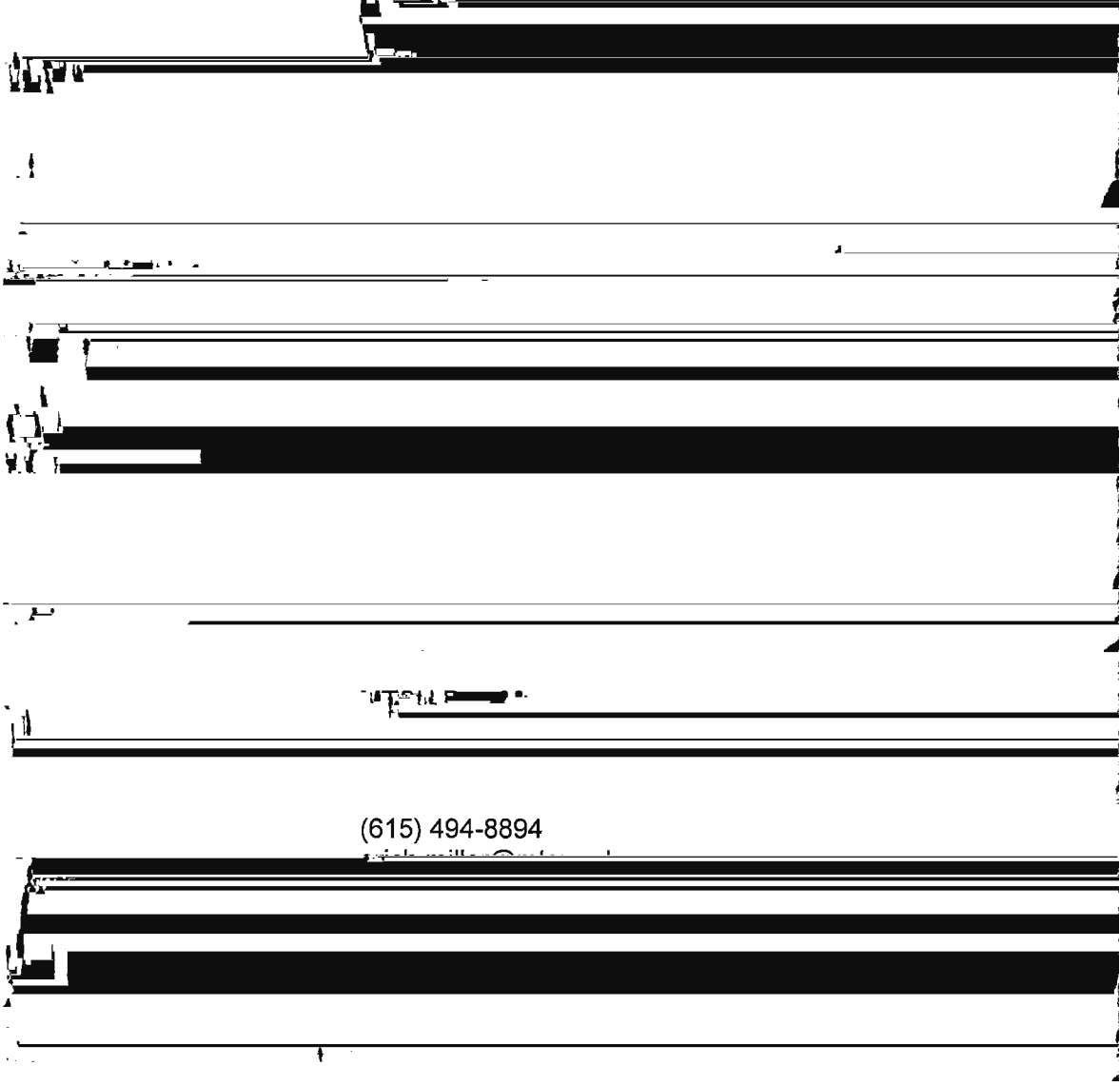

DIRECT ADMISSION PROGRAM WITH MIDDLE TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY

The purpose of the Direct Admission Program is to recruit highly qualified, talented students early in their college careers and to streamline their admission to the Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) program at Union University.

Students admitted to Middle Tennessee State University as freshmen automatically qualify for Direct Admission. A currently enrolled Middle Tennessee State University student must complete a minimum of 28 of the required pharmacy prerequisite hours at Middle Tennessee State University (at least 14 hours of science and math). A currently enrolled Middle Tennessee State University student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Progression Criteria

- Complete all pharmacy prerequisites prior to matriculation into the Union University College of Pharmacy (UUCOP) with a grade of "C" or higher in each course.
